

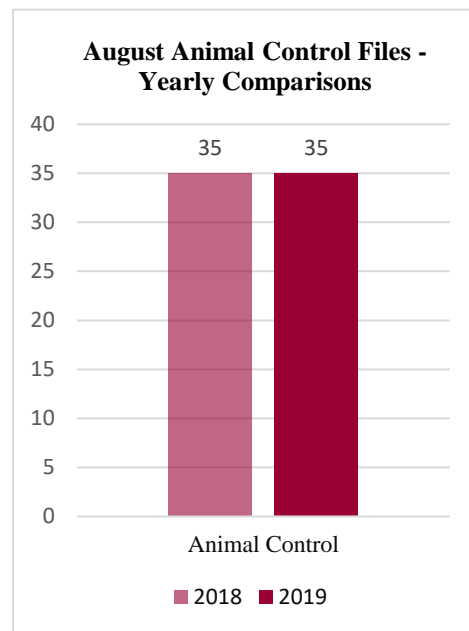
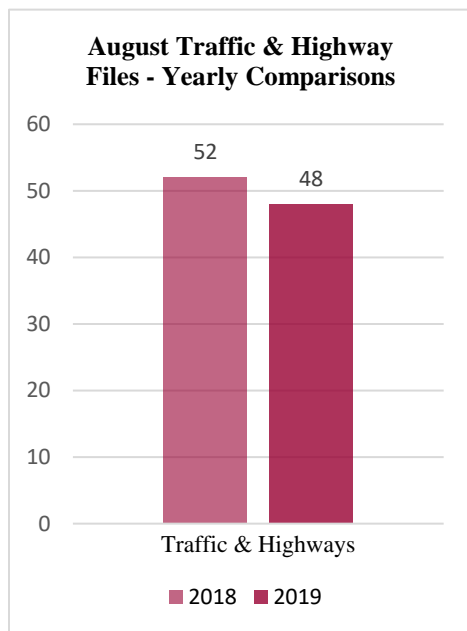

### Bylaw of the Month – Traffic & Highway Bylaw No. 1400

- Staff focused on educating the public on the rules and regulations for parking in Revelstoke. The website highlighted some areas of the bylaw which included:
  - Maximum parking time limits are set out on signage, parking facing the wrong direction, impeding a crosswalk or fire hydrant, or parking at a yellow curb are a few examples of parking regulations in Revelstoke.
  - Locations of all 24-hour parking lots in Revelstoke and that no camping is permitted in each of these lots.
