#### LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN CONTRACT AWARD

Council approved Phase 2 and 3 of the Liquid Waste Management Plan (LWMP) be awarded to McElhanney Ltd. in the amount of \$93,470.

This work is to complete the LWMP for long-term planning and to address current liquid waste issues.
