Council approved DP2019-23 and DVP2022-003 to permit the construction of a 24 unit apartment complex at 1219 Victoria Road.

ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2330 (ZON2021-005)

Council gave First and Second readings to [Bylaw No. 2330](#), which aims to create a new *Residential Tourist Accommodation (RTA-01) Zone* for the City and to rezone 1944 Leidloff Road to the RTA-01 Zone.
