REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

This is a summary of the decisions made at the Council table.

CORPORATE SERVICES

MUNICIPAL & DISTRICT TAX (MDRT) LEVEY AMENDMENT BYLAW

Council adopted Municipal & District Tax Levy Amendment [Bylaw No. 2343](#) to increase MDRT taxes from 2% to 3% and expand the collection area to include CSRD Area B. Once approved by the Ministry, the MRDT taxes will be collected at a rate of 3% beginning May 2023 from all accommodators in the City and CSRD Area B.

ROAD CLOSURE BYLAW - 1160 NEWLANDS ROAD

Council adopted Road Closure [Bylaw No. 2339](#) to facilitate closure to traffic and removal of highway dedication of 81.65 m2 portion of highway adjacent to 1160 Newlands Road and subsequent disposal to the owners of 1160 Newlands Road.
