- * **LEARN about infill redevelopment** as a possible solution to many of Revelstoke's challenges. A continuation of the **OCP Speakers Series, Peter Whitelaw of HB Lanarc**, a planning firm specializing in community sustainability will bring the issues home and explore real options. It's a chance to see what's been done elsewhere and to discuss how that experience can be applied to help meet Revelstoke's unique challenges.

- * **COMMENT** on the **draft OCP document and maps**, through discussions and via a brief questionnaire (*the questionnaire will also be distributed after the meeting either at City Hall or online at www.cityofrevelstoke.com*).

Meeting Displays:

The draft Land Use Plans that will be part of the OCP (considering Urban Growth Areas, Future Growth Areas, Areas with Environmental Sensitivity, Heritage Conservation Areas, Land Use Designations, Transportation and Infrastructure Improvements, and Parks and Trails) will also be on display for comment.

The OCP will continue to provide opportunities for resident and stakeholder input through the remaining four month process.
